I recently learned of the proposed rule put forth by the GASB that would require state and local governments to disclose the total amount of property tax and other abatements in any year. I am emailing to express my support for the the rule, but to also express my hope that a broader rule can be put forth. State and local governments should have to disclose all subsidies given to businesses. All details, including recipients of the subsidies, any fees paid and any campaign contributions made by the businesses, and accounting of how many jobs were created should all be disclosed.
