I understand that the GASB is inviting comment on the proposed rule change to fully disclose all state and local tax information on property taxes that are reduced or waived entirely on new or refurbished factories, hotels, office buildings and other business real estate.

Not only do I support this rule as proposed, but I demand a much broader one. I want disclosure of all state and local subsidies to businesses I want the recipients and their brokers fully identified along with any fees paid, any campaign contributions by the companies and brokers and a rigorous accounting of how many jobs were added, if any. And I want disclosures to cover the entire period of each deal as well as annual snapshots.
